*Middle/High School Student Artist:

To be eligible for the student entry fee rate, artist must be between the ages of 12-18 years old and must be enrolled in a middle or secondary educational institution/home school, and have parent/guardian permission to enter the festival.

Submission and Media Categories

To be considered for the HDALF, artists will submit original works in the following media categories: Paintings and prints, sculpture, clay art, textile art, photography, art glass, mixed media, and original fine art jewelry. Reproductions are allowed provided they are limited editions, signed and numbered and clearly indicated as a reproduction.

Specifically Excluded from this Festival

Works over 20"x24" dimensions; commercially or mass-produced items; RESALE or BUY/SELL merchandise; clay or ceramic art must be hand-thrown or hand-formed — no molds. The Festival Committee reserves the right to refuse or remove exhibition of work not consistent with submitted photos or these guidelines.
