

Advancing equity for women and girls in the Victor Valley since 1955

Celebrating Women in Math and Science Conference: Our collaboration with Victor Valley College started in 1985. It evolved from a Girls Math and Science Conference to a Women's Career Conference and back to a Girls' conference. We partnered with Victor Valley College, VVC STEM Department and San Bernardino County Superintendent of Schools to present Celebrating Women in Mathematics and Science, a one-day conference for middle school and high school girls. Our 13th conference will be held at VVC for 300 8th-grade girls on January 25, 2019.

Memorial Scholarships: AAUW Victor Valley has been providing scholarships to women returning to education at Victor Valley College since 1975. Since 1991, 147 Memorial Scholarships totaling \$100,070 have been given. For 2017-2018, we awarded 4 students with \$1,500 scholarships.

Tech Trek STEM Camp: Since 2005, 76 Victor Valley girls completing the seventh grade to week long AAUW Tech Trek Math and Science Camp totaling \$78,500.
